- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 121, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 121.2017 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 121.2017. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR PIPELINES IN CERTAIN
- 8 POPULOUS COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a gas pipeline
- 9 located or proposed to be located in a county that:
- 10 (1) has a population of more than 1.4 million; and
- 11 (2) is located wholly or partly above a
- 12 hydrocarbon-producing geological formation in which during the
- 13 preceding year the Railroad Commission of Texas issued more than
- 14 2,000 drilling permits authorizing gas wells to be completed.
- 15 (b) A gathering or transmission pipeline may not be
- 16 constructed within 300 feet of an established permanent structure
- 17 that is used by human beings on a regular basis.
- 18 <u>(c) Notwithstanding Section 121.252, gas produced from a</u>
- 19 well located in a county described by Subsection (a) of this section
- 20 must be odorized at the wellhead in accordance with the methodology
- 21 prescribed by 49 C.F.R. Section 192.625 before the gas enters a
- 22 gathering pipeline.

- 23 (d) The pipe used in a gathering or transmission pipeline
- 24 must be constructed of high-grade materials.

- 1 (e) A gathering or transmission pipeline must be protected
- 2 from exterior corrosion through the use of adequate coatings and
- 3 <u>cathodic protection</u>.
- 4 (f) Gas produced from a well located in a county described
- 5 by Subsection (a) must be dehydrated at the wellhead before the gas
- 6 enters a gathering pipeline, or a pipeline integrity assessment by
- 7 <u>in-line</u> inspection or a pressure test of the gathering pipeline
- 8 transporting the gas must be conducted every two years.
- 9 (g) The railroad commission shall adopt rules to implement
- 10 this section.
- 11 (h) This section and railroad commission rules adopted to
- 12 implement this section shall be enforced in the same manner as
- 13 Section 121.201 and safety standards or other rules prescribed or
- 14 adopted under that section.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
- 16 date of this Act, the Railroad Commission of Texas shall adopt rules
- 17 to implement Section 121.2017, Utilities Code, as added by this
- 18 Act.
- 19 (b) Section 121.2017(b), Utilities Code, as added by this
- 20 Act, applies only to a pipeline constructed on or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act.
- (c) A pipeline subject to this Act that is in existence on
- 23 the effective date of this Act is not required to be brought into
- 24 compliance with Sections 121.2017(c)-(f), Utilities Code, as added
- 25 by this Act, until January 1, 2012.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
