2	relating to local public health and public safety alerts.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 418, Government Code, is amended by
5	adding Subchapter I to read as follows:
6	SUBCHAPTER I. LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH AND PUBLIC SAFETY ALERTS
7	Sec. 418.190. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
8	(1) "Emergency management director" means a person
9	designated to serve as emergency management director under Section
10	418.1015.
11	(2) "Health authority" has the meaning assigned by
12	Section 81.003, Health and Safety Code.
13	Sec. 418.191. LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH AND PUBLIC SAFETY ALERTS.
14	With the cooperation of the Texas Department of Transportation and
15	emergency management directors, the division shall develop and
16	implement a system for municipalities and counties to issue local
17	public health and public safety alerts through an existing system
18	of dynamic message signs. The local public health and public safety
19	alerts may include public service messages provided to motorists:
20	(1) during a severe weather advisory;
21	(2) during an evacuation that has been ordered; or
22	(3) following a declaration of a state of disaster
23	issued under this chapter.
24	Sec. 418.192. ADMINISTRATION. (a) The division shall

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1	coordinate the local public health and public safety alert system.
2	(b) The division shall adopt standards as necessary to
3	ensure proper implementation of the alert system. The standards
4	must address:
5	(1) the procedures to be used by a health authority to
6	verify a threat to public health within the health authority's
7	jurisdiction;
8	(2) the procedures to be used by a local law
9	enforcement agency to verify a threat to public safety within the
10	agency's jurisdiction; and
11	(3) the procedures to be used by an individual or
12	entity to report information about a threat to public health or
13	public safety.
14	(c) The division shall prescribe forms for use by an
15	emergency management director for a municipality or county in
16	requesting activation of the alert system.
17	Sec. 418.193. DUTIES OF TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.
18	(a) The Texas Department of Transportation shall:
19	(1) cooperate with the division and emergency
20	management directors and assist in developing and implementing the
21	alert system; and
22	(2) establish a plan for providing relevant
23	information to the public in affected areas of the state through an
24	existing system of dynamic message signs.
25	(b) The Texas Department of Transportation may coordinate
26	the implementation of its duties under this subchapter with the
27	implementation of the silver alert system under Subchapter M,

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1 Chapter 411.

(c) The Texas Department of Transportation shall coordinate
with the division to determine additional methods of disseminating
local public health and safety alerts under Section 418.191, AMBER
alerts under Subchapter L, Chapter 411, and silver alerts under
Subchapter M, Chapter 411, using existing resources.

Sec. 418.194. NOTIFICATION TO DIVISION OF LOCAL THREAT TO
 PUBLIC HEALTH OR PUBLIC SAFETY. (a) An emergency management
 director may notify the division if the emergency management
 director receives notice from:

11 (1) a health authority of a verified threat to public 12 health within the health authority's jurisdiction; or

13 (2) a local law enforcement agency of a verified
14 threat to public safety within the agency's jurisdiction.

15 (b) The emergency management director must determine that 16 the information provided by a health authority or a local law 17 enforcement agency poses a credible threat to the municipality or 18 county.

19 <u>Sec. 418.195. ACTIVATION. (a) On the request of an</u> 20 <u>emergency management director, the division shall activate the</u> 21 <u>alert system and notify appropriate participants in the alert</u> 22 <u>system.</u>

23 (b) The division shall send the alert to designated media 24 outlets in the area affected by the public health or public safety 25 threat. Following receipt of the alert, participating media 26 outlets may issue the alert at designated intervals.

27 Sec. 418.196. CONTENT OF LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH OR PUBLIC

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- SAFETY ALERT. A local public health or public safety alert must 1 2 include: 3 (1) all appropriate information that is provided by 4 the emergency management director; and 5 (2) information on whom an individual in the affected 6 area can contact for more information. 7 Sec. 418.197. TERMINATION OF LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH OR PUBLIC SAFETY ALERT. (a) The division shall terminate any activation of 8 9 the alert with respect to a local public health or public safety alert not later than the earlier of the time at which: 10 (1) the local public health or public safety threat is 11 12 resolved; or (2) the notification period ends, as determined by 13 14 standards adopted by the division. 15 (b) An emergency management director that requests activation of the alert system under this subchapter shall notify 16 17 the division as soon as possible that the local public health or public safety threat is resolved. 18
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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
