A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the continuation and functions of the board of
- 3 directors of the official cotton growers' boll weevil eradication
- 4 foundation.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 74.113, Agriculture Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (f) and adding Subsection (l) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (f) An assessment levied on cotton growers in an eradication
- 10 zone may be applied only to:
- 11 (1) eradication [in that zone];
- 12 (2) the foundation's operating costs, including
- 13 payments on debt incurred for a foundation activity[, except that
- 14 the funds of one zone may not be used to pay another zone's bank
- 15 loans or debts]; and
- 16 (3) the conducting of other programs consistent with
- 17 the declaration of policy stated in Section 74.101.
- (1) With the approval of the board and the commissioner, the
- 19 foundation may transfer the proceeds from the collection of
- 20 <u>assessments in one eradication zone to another eradication zone.</u>
- 21 The board shall consult with affected cotton grower steering
- 22 <u>committees before recommending that the commissioner approve the</u>
- 23 transfer of proceeds under this subsection. The transferred
- 24 proceeds may be applied only as provided by Subsection (f).

- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 74, Agriculture Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 74.1135 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 74.1135. ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF ASSESSMENTS. (a) The
- 4 commissioner may adopt rules that provide for an alternative
- 5 method, manner, and mechanism by which assessments are imposed and
- 6 collected under this subchapter. The commissioner may adopt the
- 7 rules only after receiving a recommendation from the board. The
- 8 board shall consult with cotton grower steering committees and the
- 9 technical advisory committee in formulating a recommendation to the
- 10 commissioner under this subsection. The commissioner may accept,
- 11 reject, or modify a board recommendation. The rules apply
- 12 notwithstanding Section 74.113. The rules must require any person
- 13 collecting an assessment to forward the assessment to the
- 14 foundation.
- 15 (b) The maximum amount of an assessment under this section
- 16 may not exceed the maximum amount of an assessment approved in an
- 17 assessment referendum under this subchapter.
- SECTION 3. Section 74.127(a), Agriculture Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (a) The board of directors of the official cotton growers'
- 21 boll weevil eradication foundation is subject to Chapter 325,
- 22 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence
- 23 as provided by that chapter, the board is abolished and this
- 24 subchapter expires September 1, 2021 [2009].
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
