- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 61.003(a), Government Code, as amended
- 5 by Chapters 661 (H.B. 1204) and 1378 (S.B. 560), Acts of the 80th
- 6 Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, is reenacted and amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) Each person who reports for jury service shall be
- 9 personally provided a form letter that when signed by the person
- 10 directs the county treasurer to donate all, or a specific amount
- 11 designated by the person, of the person's daily reimbursement under
- 12 this chapter to:
- 13 (1) the compensation to victims of crime fund under
- 14 Subchapter B, Chapter 56, Code of Criminal Procedure;
- 15 (2) the child welfare board of the county appointed
- 16 under Section 264.005, Family Code;
- 17 (3) any programs or resources selected by the
- 18 commissioners court that provide support for child abuse prevention
- 19 and child protection;
- $\underline{(4)}$  any program selected by the commissioners court
- 21 that is operated by a public or private nonprofit organization and
- 22 that provides shelter and services to victims of family violence;
- 23 or
- (5)  $\left[\frac{(4)}{(4)}\right]$  any other program approved by the

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- 1 commissioners court of the county, including a program established
- 2 under Article 56.04(f), Code of Criminal Procedure, that offers
- 3 psychological counseling to jurors in criminal cases involving
- 4 graphic evidence or testimony.
- 5 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 6 to donations from jurors appearing in response to a summons issued
- 7 on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
