## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 31.032(d), Human Resources Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	(d) In determining whether an applicant is eligible for
9	assistance, the department shall exclude from the applicant's
10	available resources:
11	(1) \$1,000 for the applicant's household, including a
12	household in which there is a person with a disability or a person
13	who is at least 60 years of age; [and]
14	(2) the fair market value of each motor vehicle:
15	(A) in which the applicant or any other person in
16	the applicant's household has an ownership interest; and
17	(B) the fair market value of which is less than
18	\$4,650;
19	(3) each motor vehicle that may be excluded under 7

21	(4) the fair market value of the motor vehicle, other

is amended by adding Section 32.0265 to read as follows:

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- 1 ALLOWANCES. (a) To the extent allowed by federal law and except as
- 2 provided by Subsection (b), for purposes of determining whether a
- 3 person meets the resource requirements for eligibility for medical
- 4 assistance, the department shall exclude from the person's
- 5 resources the motor vehicle allowances that would be excluded under
- 6 Section 31.032(d) if the person were an applicant for financial
- 7 <u>assistance</u>.
- 8 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply in determining the
- 9 eligibility of a person for medical assistance if a less
- 10 restrictive provision relating to motor vehicle allowances would
- 11 otherwise apply in determining the person's eligibility for a
- 12 specific category of medical assistance.
- SECTION 3. Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, is amended by
- 14 adding Section 33.014 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 33.014. DETERMINATION OF RESOURCES: MOTOR VEHICLE
- 16 ALLOWANCES. For purposes of determining whether a person meets the
- 17 resource requirements for eligibility for food stamps, the
- 18 department shall exclude from the person's resources the motor
- 19 vehicle allowances that would be excluded under Section 31.032(d)
- 20 if the person were an applicant for financial assistance.
- 21 SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 22 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 23 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 24 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 25 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 26 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 27 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply to an

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- 1 initial determination or redetermination of eligibility of a person
- 2 for financial assistance under Chapter 31, Human Resources Code,
- 3 medical assistance under Chapter 32, Human Resources Code, or the
- 4 food stamp program under Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, that is
- 5 made on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
