## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

5	SECTION 1. Section 2306.097, Government Code, is amended to

7	Sec. 2306.097. ENERGY SERVICES PROGRAM FOR LOW-INCOME
8	INDIVIDUALS. (a) The Energy Services Program for Low-Income
9	Individuals shall operate in conjunction with the community
10	services block grant program and has jurisdiction and
11	responsibility for administration of the following elements of the
12	State Low-Income Energy Assistance Program, from whatever sources
13	funded:
14	(1) the Energy Crisis Intervention Program;
15	(2) the weatherization program; and
16	(3) the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program.
17	(b) Subject to applicable state and federal law, the
18	department shall enter into an interagency agreement with the
19	Health and Human Services Commission to provide a payment of \$1 each
20	year under the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program to each
21	household that receives food stamp benefits under the food stamp
22	program administered under Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, if the

in an increase in the household's food stamp benefits. The
interagency agreement entered into under this subsection must:
(1) specify that the commission will issue the
payments;
(2) require the department to transfer to the
commission funds, including sufficient administrative funds, to
provide the payments; and
(3) specify the method that the commission will use
for providing the payments.
SECTION 2. (a) Not later than November 1, 2009, the Texas
Department of Housing and Community Affairs and the Health and
Human Services Commission shall enter into the interagency
agreement required by Section 2306.097(b), Government Code, as
added by this Act.
(b) Not later than December 1, 2009, the Health and Human
Services Commission shall begin making payments under the
Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program to recipients of food
stamp benefits under Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, as required
under Section 2306.097(b), Government Code, as added by this Act.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
