A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the extent and management of the John Graves Scenic
- 3 Riverway.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 26.551(2), Water Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (2) "John Graves Scenic Riverway" means that portion
- 8 of the Brazos River Basin, and its contributing watershed, located
- 9 downstream of the Morris Shepard Dam on the Possum Kingdom
- 10 Reservoir in Palo Pinto County, Texas, and extending to the county
- 11 line between Somervell and Bosque [Parker and Hood] Counties,
- 12 Texas, including that portion of the river basin and contributing
- 13 <u>watershed in Johnson County</u>.
- SECTION 2. Section 26.555(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (b) The visual inspections and the drawing of water samples
- 17 must be conducted at least once in a winter month and at least once
- 18 in a summer month. The visual inspections must be conducted [both]
- 19 from the surface of the John Graves Scenic Riverway or [and] from an
- 20 aircraft flying over the riverway.
- 21 SECTION 3. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as
- 22 soon as practicable shall amend its rules as necessary to include in
- 23 the John Graves Scenic Riverway pilot program under Subchapter M,
- 24 Chapter 26, Water Code, the area added to the John Graves Scenic

- 1 Riverway by this Act. The commission shall begin enforcement of
- 2 Subchapter M, Chapter 26, Water Code, in the area added to the John
- 3 Graves Scenic Riverway on January 1, 2010.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
