- 9 laboratory services" means the performance of tests to analyze
- specimens collected as part of the newborn screenings performed 10
- 11 under Subchapter B, Chapter 33.
- 12 (b) Notwithstanding Section 12.0122 or other law, the
- department may enter into a mutual aid agreement to provide newborn 13
- 14 screening laboratory services to another state and to receive
- newborn screening laboratory services from another state in the 15
- 16 event of an unexpected interruption of service, including an
- interruption caused by a disaster. 17
- 18 (c) Each mutual aid agreement under Subsection (b) shall
