- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 12, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 12.01221 to read as follows:
- 7 <u>Sec. 12.01221.</u> MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FOR NEWBORN SCREENING
- 8 LABORATORY SERVICES. (a) In this section, "newborn screening
- 9 laboratory services" means the performance of tests to analyze
- 10 specimens collected as part of the newborn screenings performed
- 11 under Subchapter B, Chapter 33.
- 12 (b) Notwithstanding Section 12.0122 or other law, the
- 13 <u>department may enter into a mutual aid agreement to provide newborn</u>
- 14 screening laboratory services to another state and to receive
- 15 newborn screening laboratory services from another state in the
- 16 event of an unexpected interruption of service, including an
- 17 interruption caused by a disaster.
- 18 <u>(c) Each mutual aid agreement under Subsection (b) shall</u>
- 19 include provisions:
- (1) to address the confidentiality of the identity of
- 21 the newborn child and the newborn child's family; and
- (2) to ensure the return of blood specimens and
- 23 related records to the state that received the newborn screening
- 24 laboratory services.
