Subchapter B, Chapter 12, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Section 12.01221 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 12.01221. MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FOR NEWBORN SCREENING 7 LABORATORY SERVICES. (a) In this section, "newborn screening 8 9 laboratory services" means the performance of tests to analyze specimens collected as part of the newborn screenings performed 10 11 under Subchapter B, Chapter 33. 12 (b) Notwithstanding Section 12.0122 or other law, the department may enter into a mutual aid agreement to provide newborn 13 14 screening laboratory services to another state and to receive newborn screening laboratory services from another state in the 15 16 event of an unexpected interruption of service, including an interruption caused by a disaster. 17 18 (c) Each mutual aid agreement under Subsection (b) shall 19 include provisions: (1) to address the confidentiality of the identity of 20 21 the newborn child and the newborn child's family; and 22 (2) to ensure the return of blood specimens and 23 related records to the state that received the newborn screening 24 laboratory services.
