- 9 to be delinquent or in need of supervision under Section 54.03(f) or

- 12 SECTION 2. Section 56.01, Family Code, is amended by
- 13 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to

- 15 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), an [An] appeal
- 16 from an order of a juvenile court is to a court of appeals and the
- 17 case may be carried to the Texas Supreme Court by writ of error or
- 18 upon certificate, as in civil cases generally.
- 19 (b) The requirements governing an appeal are as in civil
- 20 cases generally. When an appeal is sought by filing a notice of
- 21 appeal, security for costs of appeal, or an affidavit of inability
- 22 to pay the costs of appeal, and the filing is made in a timely
- 23 fashion after the date the disposition order is signed, the appeal
- 24 must include the juvenile court adjudication and all rulings

- 2 may be sought notwithstanding that the adjudication order was
- 3 signed more than 30 days before the date the notice of appeal,
- 4 security for costs of appeal, or affidavit of inability to pay the

- 6 $\underline{(b-1)}$ A motion for new trial seeking to vacate an
- 7 adjudication is:
- 8 (1) timely if the motion is filed not later than the
- 9 30th day after the date on which the disposition order is signed;
- 10 <u>and</u>
- 11 (2) governed by Rule 21, Texas Rules of Appellate
- 12 Procedure.
- SECTION 3. Section 56.01, Family Code, as amended by this
- 14 Act, applies to a motion for a new trial filed after a disposition
- 15 order that is signed on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 16 motion for a new trial filed after a disposition order that is
- 17 signed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law
- 18 in effect on the date that the disposition order was signed, and
- 19 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
