A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to accountability for gifted and talented programs 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 39, Education Code, is amended by adding 5 Section 39.117, to read as follows: Section 39.117. GIFTED AND TALENTED STANDARDS. 6 The commissioner shall adopt standards for the evaluation of gifted and 7 talented programs. A school that uses the Texas Performance 8 9 Standards Project or another program approved by the commissioner that meets the requirements of the Texas state plan for the 10 11 education of gifted and talented students under section 29.123 and 12 receives a satisfactory rating under the standards set by the commissioner shall not be subject to the limitation under 42.156 13 14 (c) for the following two school years. If a district fails to receive a satisfactory rating for two consecutive school years, it 15 16 shall be subject to the limitation under 42.156 (c) until the year following a satisfactory rating. 17 Section 2. Section 42.156 (c) is amended to read as follows: 18 Except as provided in Section 39.117, not more than five 19 (c) percent of a district's students in average daily attendance are 20 21 eligible for funding under this section.

22 Section 3. The commissioner shall adopt standards for the 23 evaluation of gifted and talented programs for the evaluation of 24 gifted and talented programs no later than September 1, 2010.

1 Section 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
