9 PENSION SYSTEM. (a) Information concerning the employment of an

11 under the terms of this chapter, including information concerning

13 system by the employee in the person's capacity as an employee of

14 the system, and is not removed from the application of this chapter,

(b) Information concerning the service of a trustee of a

- 8 SECTION 2. Section 552.0221, Government Code, as added by
- 9 this Act, applies only in relation to a request for public
- 10 information made on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
