A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to requiring certain facilities located in certain areas
- 3 prone to severe weather to have an emergency preparedness plan for
- 4 provision of emergency electrical power.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 531.098 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 531.098. EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLAN FOR FACILITIES
- 9 LOCATED IN AREAS PRONE TO SEVERE WEATHER. (a) For purposes of this
- 10 section, "area prone to severe weather" means each county in this
- 11 state that is located wholly or partly within 100 miles of the Gulf
- 12 of Mexico.

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- 13 (b) This section applies only to a facility located in an
- 14 area prone to severe weather that is licensed by a health and human
- 15 services agency and that serves elderly persons, persons who are
- 16 ill, and persons with special needs.
- 17 <u>(c) The executive commissioner by rule shall require</u> a
- 18 facility to which this section applies to annually adopt and submit
- 19 to the commission for its approval an emergency preparedness plan
- 20 that ensures that, in the event of a local power outage, the
- 21 <u>facility maintains the ability:</u>
- 22 (1) to provide emergency electrical power; and
- 23 (2) to meet the basic needs of all persons receiving
- 24 services at the facility.

- 1 (d) The commission shall review and approve or disapprove an
- 2 emergency preparedness plan submitted under Subsection (c) and
- 3 <u>issue a notification of approval or a notification of the reasons</u>
- 4 for disapproval of the plan.
- 5 (e) An emergency preparedness plan must demonstrate that
- 6 the facility possesses on the facility's premises an electrical
- 7 power generator or other emergency power source. The facility must
- 8 include with the plan a proposed schedule for the regular
- 9 servicing, testing, and operation of the electrical power generator
- 10 or other emergency power source that complies with commission
- 11 rules. A facility shall maintain a log of the regular servicing,
- 12 testing, and operation of the electrical power generator or other
- 13 emergency power source and shall submit a copy of the log to the
- 14 commission with its annual emergency preparedness plan. The
- 15 commission may inspect the log at any time before the facility
- 16 <u>submits the log to the commission.</u>
- 17 (f) The executive commissioner by rule shall prescribe
- 18 standards relating to the servicing, testing, and operation of an
- 19 electrical power generator or other emergency power source used in
- 20 the implementation of an emergency preparedness plan submitted
- 21 under Subsection (c).
- 22 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2009, the executive
- 23 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 24 adopt rules as required by Section 531.098, Government Code, as
- 25 added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. A facility licensed by a health and human
- 27 services agency required to adopt and submit an emergency

- 1 preparedness plan under Section 531.098, Government Code, as added
- 2 by this Act, shall comply with rules adopted under that section not
- 3 later than January 31, 2010.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
