- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 531.098 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 531.098. RULES AND PROVISION RELATING TO FACILITIES
- 8 LOCATED IN AREAS PRONE TO SEVERE WEATHER. (a) The executive
- 9 commissioner shall adopt rules defining areas in this state that
- 10 are prone to severe weather as each coastal county and any other
- 11 county in which a state of disaster has been declared by an
- 12 <u>executive order or proclamation under Chapter 418, Government Code,</u>
- 13 <u>issued on or after January 1, 2003. The executive commissioner</u>
- 14 shall update the rules as necessary.
- 15 (b) The executive commissioner may require a facility
- 16 located in an area prone to severe weather that is licensed by a
- 17 health and human services agency and that serves elderly persons,
- 18 persons who are ill, and persons with special needs to have an
- 19 emergency generator located on the premises to provide emergency
- 20 <u>electrical power.</u>

- 21 SECTION 2. Section 242.037, Health and Safety Code, is
- 22 amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 23 <u>(j) The minimum standards adopted by the executive</u>
- 24 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission under this

- 10 section must require that each assisted living facility located in
- 11 an area prone to severe weather under rules adopted by the executive
- 12 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission under
- 13 Section 531.098, Government Code, provide emergency electrical
- 14 power with an emergency generator located on the premises.
- 15 SECTION 4. Section 248.026, Health and Safety Code, is
- 16 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 17 (c) The minimum standards adopted by the executive
- 18 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission under this
- 19 section must require that each special care facility located in an
- 20 area prone to severe weather under rules adopted by the executive
- 21 <u>commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission under</u>
- 22 Section 531.098, Government Code, provide emergency electrical
- 23 power with an emergency generator located on the premises.
- SECTION 5. Not later than January 1, 2010, the executive
- 25 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 26 adopt:
- 27 (1) the rules required by Section 531.098, Government

- 1 Code, as added by this Act; and
- 2 (2) the standards required by Sections 242.037(j),
- 3 247.026(j), and 248.026(c), Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 4 this Act.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
