9	inspector general may issue an administrative subpoena to a
10	communications common carrier or an electronic communications
11	service to compel the production of the carrier's or service's
12	<pre>business records that:</pre>
13	(1) disclose information about:
14	(A) the carrier's or service's customers; or
15	(B) users of the services offered by the carrier
16	or service; and
17	(2) are material to a criminal investigation of a
18	potential escape, violation of Section 38.11, Penal Code, or other
19	offense involving inmates or the operations of the department.
20	(b) In this section:
21	(1) "Communications common carrier" means a person
22	that provides commercial telephone services or a provider that
23	bills customers for those services, regardless of the technology

24 used to provide the service.

- 2 <u>service that provides to users of the service the ability to send or</u>
