8	make available for rebates during a fiscal year the entire amount of
9	money made available for rebates during the preceding fiscal year
10	that was not spent during the preceding fiscal year. The amount of
11	money made available for rebates during the preceding fiscal year
12	that was not spent during the preceding fiscal year is not counted
13	in determining the limitation on the proportion of the fund usable
14	for the rebate program during a fiscal year.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
16	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
17	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
18	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
19	Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
