## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to money available for consumer incentive or rebate

- 3 programs for alternatively fueled appliances or equipment.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 113.2435, Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) Notwithstanding Subsection (c)(5), the commission shall
- 8 make available for rebates during a fiscal year the entire amount of
- 9 money made available for rebates during the preceding fiscal year
- 10 that was not spent during the preceding fiscal year. The amount of
- 11 money made available for rebates during the preceding fiscal year
- 12 that was not spent during the preceding fiscal year is not counted
- 13 <u>in determining the limitation on the proportion of the fund usable</u>
- 14 for the rebate program during a fiscal year.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
