## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the regulation of the towing and storage of vehicles.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2303.1015(a), Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A person may not work at a vehicle storage facility
- 7 unless the person holds a license issued under this chapter  $\underline{\text{or}}$
- 8 Chapter 2308.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 2308.153(b), Occupations Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (b) An applicant for an incident management towing
- 12 operator's license must:
- 13 (1) hold a valid driver's license issued by a state in
- 14 the United States [be a licensed Texas driver]; and
- 15 (2) be certified by a [the National Drivers
- 16 Certification Program of the Towing and Recovery Association of
- 17 America or another certification] program approved by the
- 18 department.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 2308.154(b), Occupations Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (b) An applicant for a private property towing operator's
- 22 license must:
- 23 (1) <u>hold a valid driver's license issued by a state in</u>
- 24 the United States [be a licensed Texas driver]; and

- 1 (2) be certified by a [the National Drivers
- 2 Certification Program of the Towing and Recovery Association of
- 3 America or another certification] program approved by the
- 4 department.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 2308.155(b), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) An applicant for a consent towing operator's license
- 8 must hold a valid driver's license issued by a state in the United
- 9 States [be a licensed Texas driver].
- SECTION 5. Subchapter D, Chapter 2308, Occupations Code, is
- 11 amended by adding Section 2308.1551 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 2308.1551. TEMPORARY TRAINING LICENSE. (a) The
- 13 department may issue a temporary training license to an applicant
- 14 for a license under this subchapter if the applicant:
- 15 (1) holds a valid driver's license issued by a state in
- 16 <u>the United States;</u>
- 17 (2) meets the qualifications established by rule by
- 18 the commission; and
- 19 (3) is engaged in the process of learning and
- 20 assisting in the operation of a tow truck under the supervision of a
- 21 tow truck operator who holds the same type of license that the
- 22 <u>applicant is seeking.</u>
- (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), an applicant for a
- 24 license under Section 2308.153 may be supervised by an operator who
- 25 holds a license issued under Section 2308.153, 2308.154, or
- 26 2308.155.
- 27 (c) A temporary training license issued under this section

- 1 expires on the 91st day after the date of issuance.
- 2 (d) The commission by rule shall set the fee, establish the
- 3 qualifications, and provide for the issuance of a temporary
- 4 training license under this section.
- 5 SECTION 6. Section 2308.158, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2308.158. ALCOHOL AND DRUG TESTING OF TOWING
- 8 OPERATORS. (a) A towing company shall establish an alcohol and  $\left[\frac{a}{a}\right]$
- 9 drug testing policy for towing operators. A towing company that
- 10 establishes an alcohol and [a] drug testing policy under this
- 11 subsection may adopt the model <u>alcohol and</u> drug testing policy
- 12 adopted by the commission or may use another alcohol and drug
- 13 testing policy that the department determines is at least as
- 14 stringent as the policy adopted by the commission.
- 15 (b) The commission by rule shall adopt a model <u>alcohol and</u>
- 16 drug testing policy for use by a towing company. The model <u>alcohol</u>
- 17 and drug testing policy must be designed to ensure the safety of the
- 18 public through appropriate <u>alcohol and</u> drug testing and to protect
- 19 the rights of employees. The model alcohol and drug testing policy
- 20 must:
- 21 (1) require at least one scheduled <u>alcohol and</u> drug
- 22 test each year for each towing operator; and
- 23 (2) authorize random, unannounced <u>alcohol and</u> drug
- 24 testing for towing operators.
- 25 SECTION 7. (a) The changes in law made by this Act to
- 26 Sections 2308.153, 2308.154, and 2308.155, Occupations Code, apply
- 27 only to a license application filed on or after the effective date

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- 1 of this Act. A license application filed before the effective date
- 2 of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the license
- 3 application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 4 that purpose.
- 5 (b) Not later than November 30, 2009, the Texas Commission
- 6 of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the model alcohol and drug
- 7 testing policy required by Section 2308.158, Occupations Code, as
- 8 amended by this Act.
- 9 (c) A towing company is not required to comply with the
- 10 alcohol and drug testing policy required by Section 2308.158,
- 11 Occupations Code, as amended by this Act, until January 1, 2010.
- 12 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
