## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the Texas Education Agency's online clearinghouse of

- 3 information concerning best practices for public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 7.009, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (e) to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (a) In coordination with the Legislative Budget Board, the
- 9 agency shall establish an online clearinghouse of information
- 10 relating to best practices of campuses, [and] school districts, and
- 11 open-enrollment charter schools. The agency shall determine the
- 12 appropriate topic categories for which a campus, district, or
- 13 charter school may submit best [regarding instruction, dropout
- 14 prevention, public school finance, resource allocation, and
- 15 business] practices. To the extent practicable, the agency shall
- 16 ensure that information provided through the online clearinghouse
- 17 is specific, actionable information relating to the best practices
- 18 of high-performing and highly efficient campuses and school
- 19 districts rather than general guidelines relating to campus and
- 20 school district operation. The information must be accessible by
- 21 campuses, school districts, open-enrollment charter schools, and
- 22 interested members of the public.
- 23 (b) The agency shall solicit and collect from the
- 24 Legislative Budget Board, centers for education research

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- 1 established under Section 1.005, and [exemplary or recognized]
- 2 school districts, campuses, and open-enrollment charter schools[ $_{\tau}$
- 3 as rated under Section 39.072, examples of best practices as
- 4 determined by the agency under Subsection (a) [relating to
- 5 instruction, dropout prevention, public school finance, resource
- 6 allocation, and business practices, including best practices
- 7 relating to curriculum, scope and sequence, compensation and
- 8 incentive systems, bilingual education and special language
- 9 programs, compensatory education programs, and the effective use of
- 10 instructional technology, including online courses].
- 11 (e) The agency shall create an incentive award to recognize
- 12 school districts, campuses, and open-enrollment charter schools
- 13 that submit eligible practices to the clearinghouse.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
