5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 4002, Insurance Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 4002.008 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 4002.008. STANDARDS FOR EXAMINATION PASS RATES; ANNUAL
8	REPORT. (a) This section applies only to insurance agent license
9	examinations for limited and single lines licenses, including agent
10	licenses issued under:
11	(1) Subchapters C and I, Chapter 4051; and
12	(2) Subchapters C and G, Chapter 4054.
13	(b) The commissioner or, at the commissioner's discretion,
14	a vendor under contract with the department, shall review a license
15	examination subject to this section if, during any 12-month period
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- 1 15 16 beginning on September 1 of a year, that examination exhibits an 17 overall pass rate of less than 70 percent for first-time examinees.
- (c) The department shall collect demographic information, 18 19 including, race, gender, and national origin, from an individual 20 taking a license examination subject to this section.
- 21 (d) The department shall compile an annual report based on the review required under Subsection (b). The report must indicate 22 23 whether there was any disparity in the pass rate based on 24 demographic information.

- 1 (e) The commissioner by rule may establish procedures as
- 2 necessary to:
- 3 (1) collect demographic information necessary to
- 4 implement this section; and
- 5 (2) ensure that a review required under Subsection (b)
- 6 <u>is conducted and the resulting report is prepared.</u>
- 7 <u>(f) The commissioner shall deliver the report prepared</u>
- 8 under Subsection (d) to the governor, the lieutenant governor, and
- 9 the speaker of the house of representatives not later than December
- 10 1 of each year.
- 11 SECTION 2. (a) The first 12-month period for which a
- 12 license examination review may be required under Section
- 13 4002.008(b), Insurance Code, as added by this Act, begins September
- 14 1, 2009.
- 15 (b) The commissioner of insurance shall deliver the initial
- 16 report required under Section 4002.008, Insurance Code, as added by
- 17 this Act, not later than December 1, 2010.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
