- 2 relating to a loan program to encourage the use of cleaner hydroger
- 3 fuel; providing for the issuance of bonds.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 447, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Section 447.014 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 447.014. CLEANER HYDROGEN FUEL LOAN PROGRAM. (a) The
- 8 state energy conservation office shall establish and administer a
- 9 program to make and guarantee loans to business entities, state
- 10 agencies, institutions of higher education, and political
- 11 subdivisions of this state for projects related to the manufacture,
- 12 storage, distribution, or sale in this state of hydrogen as a fuel
- 13 source.

- 14 (b) The state energy conservation office shall prioritize
- 15 program funding and the program applications process so that, in
- 16 determining eligibility for a loan or guarantee under the program
- 17 and in determining the amount of a loan or guarantee to be provided
- 18 under the program, the program favors projects:
- 19 (1) related to the manufacture of hydrogen fuel by
- 20 processes that result in the least emissions of greenhouse gases
- 21 per unit of hydrogen fuel produced; or
- 22 (2) related to the storage, distribution, or sale of
- 23 hydrogen produced by processes that result in the least emissions
- 24 of greenhouse gases per unit of hydrogen fuel produced.

- 1 (c) The Texas Public Finance Authority shall issue general
- 2 obligation bonds in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$250 million
- 3 as authorized by Section 49-q, Article III, Texas Constitution, for
- 4 the purposes of the program.
- 5 (d) The program may be funded by:
- 6 (1) the proceeds of bonds issued under Subsection (c);
- 7 <u>or</u>
- 8 (2) gifts, grants, and donations made for the purposes
- 9 of the program.
- 10 <u>(e) The comptroller may adopt rules to implement this</u>
- 11 section.
- 12 SECTION 2. The state energy conservation office shall
- 13 establish a program under Section 447.014, Government Code, as
- 14 added by this Act, not later than January 1, 2010.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect only if the constitutional
- 16 amendment proposed by the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009,
- 17 authorizing the issuance of state general obligation bonds to
- 18 stimulate economic development by providing and guaranteeing loans
- 19 to encourage the use of hydrogen as a cleaner fuel source is
- 20 approved by the voters. If that amendment is not approved by the
- 21 voters, this Act has no effect.
