- tenant: 11 NOTICE REQUIRED BY STATE LAW: The property owner's insurance 12 cannot provide coverage for your personal property. You may purchase renter's insurance, which may cover losses due to theft, 13 14 fire, or other events or occurrences, through a licensed property and casualty insurance agent. Renter's insurance may not cover 15 16 losses due to a flood. If you are eligible, you can purchase flood insurance for your personal property from the Federal Emergency 17 Management Agency through a licensed property and casualty 18 insurance agent. Additional information regarding renter's 19 insurance may be obtained from the Texas Department of Insurance at 20 21 (insert toll-free telephone number and Internet website address).
- 22 (b) The notice required by Subsection (a) may be printed in 23 the lease or in a separate document signed by the landlord or the 24 landlord's agent and the tenant.

- 1 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 2 only to a lease initially entered into on or after January 1, 2010.
- 3 (b) A lease initially entered into before January 1, 2010,
- 4 is governed by the law existing immediately before the effective
- 5 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 6 purpose.
- 7 (c) This Act does not apply to the renewal of a lease.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
