- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 25, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 25.0033 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 25.0033. PROCEEDINGS DURING CERTAIN ABSENCES OF JUDGE.
- 8 The judge of a statutory probate court may hear, determine, and
- 9 enter orders in a matter or proceeding pending in another statutory
- 10 probate court in the same county if:
- 11 (1) the judge of the other court is absent; and
- 12 (2) the presiding judge of the statutory probate
- 13 courts has not assigned a judge to the other court under Section
- 14 25.0022.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
