1-8 relating to proceedings in a statutory probate court during the
1-9 judge's absence.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 25, Government Code, is
1-12 amended by adding Section 25.0033 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 25.0033. PROCEEDINGS DURING CERTAIN ABSENCES OF JUDGE.

1-14 The judge of a statutory probate court may hear, determine, and
1-15 enter orders in a matter or proceeding pending in another statutory
1-16 probate court in the same county if:

1-17 (1) the judge of the other court is absent; and

1-18 (2) the presiding judge of the statutory probate
1-19 courts has not assigned a judge to the other court under Section
1-20 25.0022.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
