## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the prices a retail electric provider charges certain
- 3 residential customers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 39.114 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.114. PRICES CHARGED FOR FIXED PRICE CONTRACTS AND
- 8 MONTH-TO-MONTH SERVICE. (a) In this section, "fixed price
- 9 <u>contract" means a residential retail electric service contract for</u>
- 10 which the price is stated in the contract and does not change
- 11 throughout the term of the contract. The term does not include
- 12 month-to-month service.
- 13 (b) A retail electric provider may not offer month-to-month
- 14 service to a residential customer at a higher price than the price
- 15 at which the retail electric provider offers a fixed price contract
- 16 to a new or renewing residential customer.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to a contract for retail electric service entered into or renewed on
- 19 or after the effective date of this Act. A contract for retail
- 20 electric service entered into or renewed before the effective date
- 21 of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before
- 22 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 23 for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
