- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 54.224 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 54.224. DEFINITIONS. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Interinstitutional academic program" means a
- 10 program under which a student may, in accordance with a written
- 11 agreement between an institution of higher education and one or
- 12 more other institutions of higher education or private or
- 13 <u>independent institutions of higher education</u>, take courses at each
- 14 institution that is a party to the agreement as necessary to fulfill
- 15 the program's degree or certificate requirements.
- 16 (2) "Private or independent institution of higher
- 17 education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
- 19 the governing board of an institution of higher education may
- 20 exempt from the payment of tuition and required fees authorized by
- 21 this chapter a student who is taking a course, including an
- 22 interdisciplinary course, at the institution under an
- 23 interinstitutional academic program agreement but who is enrolled
- 24 primarily at another institution of higher education or at a

- 1 private or independent institution of higher education that is a
- 2 party to the agreement and to which the student is responsible for
- 3 the payment of tuition and fees.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
