- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 501.015, Government Code, is amended by
- amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (g) to read as 7
- 8 follows:
- (a) When an inmate is discharged or is released on parole, 9
- mandatory supervision, or conditional pardon, the department 10
- 11 [institutional division] shall provide the inmate with:
- 12 (1) suitable civilian clothing;
- 13 (2) money held in the inmate's trust account by the
- 14 director; and
- cash, in an amount and in the manner described by 15 (3)
- Subsection (b) and, if applicable, Subsection (g). 16
- (g) The department may contract with an appropriate 17
- financial institution in this state, without cost to the state, to 18
- make the payments to inmates required by Subsection (b) in the form 19
- of a prepaid debit card that: 20
- 21 (1) authorizes the inmate in whose name the card is
- issued to communicate a request to an unmanned teller machine or a 22
- 23 customer convenience terminal, without charge for the initial
- transaction, or to obtain property or services by debit to an 24

- 1 account at a financial institution, without charge for any
- 2 point-of-sale transaction;
- 3 (2) is offered by a financial institution the deposits
- 4 of which are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation
- 5 and that complies with any applicable requirements of federal law;
- 6 and
- 7 (3) maintains a clear audit trail to simplify the
- 8 auditing process for purposes of reports to the comptroller.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 499.155(c), Government Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (c) If an inmate is discharged or released on parole or
- 12 mandatory supervision from a transfer facility, the inmate is
- 13 entitled to receive release or discharge money from the department
- 14 [institutional division] in the same amount and manner as an inmate
- 15 is entitled to receive on release or discharge from any other
- 16 facility of the <u>department</u> [institutional division] under Section
- 17 501.015.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
