1 AN ACT 2 relating to the creation of the Texas Equine Incentive Program. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Agriculture Code, is amended by 4 5 adding Section 12.044 to read as follows: Sec. 12.044. EQUINE INCENTIVE PROGRAM. (a) The department 6 7 shall create and administer an equine incentive program to provide an incentive for the owners of certain show horses to enter the 8 9 horses as participants in horse shows in this state. The program may apply only to the following breeds of horses: 10 11 (1) thoroughbreds; 12 (2) paint horses; and 13 (3) quarter horses. 14 (b) The owner of a stallion that has sired more than five foals shall, when the owner submits a breeding report to the 15 applicable breeders' association, submit a duplicate of the report 16 to the department for the sixth and any subsequent foal sired by the 17 stallion. An owner required to submit a duplicate breeding report 18 by this subsection shall pay the department an equine incentive 19 program fee in an amount of not less than \$30, as determined by the 20 department, in connection with each report submitted to the 21

department.

- 5 (d) The department by rule shall establish a point system by
- 6 which the owner of an eligible foal may receive an equine incentive
- 7 award based on the foal's participation in horse show events
- 8 sanctioned by the applicable horse breeders' association.
