- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 121.005, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsections (d), (e), and (f) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(d)</u> The railroad commission may:
- 9 (1) review a certification made by a person under
- 10 Subsection (a) to determine whether the person is eligible for an
- 11 exemption under that subsection; and
- 12 (2) require the person making a certification to
- 13 <u>submit any additional information the railroad commission</u>
- 14 considers necessary to make the determination.
- 15 (e) The railroad commission, after notice and opportunity
- 16 for a hearing, shall revoke an exemption granted to a person under
- 17 Subsection (a) if the commission determines that the person is not
- 18 eligible for the exemption.
- 19 (f) Nothing in this section constitutes authority to revoke
- 20 a person's operating permit based solely on a revocation under
- 21 Subsection (e). The commission shall develop rules for informing
- 22 the person of the additional statutory and regulatory requirements
- 23 caused by the loss of the exemption. On revocation of an exemption,
- 24 the commission shall specify the required procedures and deadlines
