A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to rules of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality 3 related to motor vehicle idling. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 382.0191, Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 382.0191. [HDLING OF] MOTOR VEHICLE IDLING; OFFENSE 7 [WHILE USING SLEEPER BERTH]. (a) In this section, "idling" means 8 allowing an engine to run while the motor vehicle is not engaged in 9 forward or reverse motion. 10 A rule adopted by the commission under Section 382.019 11 (b) 12 that limits or prohibits the idling of motor vehicles: 13 (1) [The commission] may not prohibit or limit the 14 idling of a motor vehicle when idling is necessary to power a heater or air conditioner while a driver is using the vehicle's sleeper 15 16 berth for a government-mandated rest period; (2) must apply only to vehicles with a gross vehicle 17 weight rating of 6,000 pounds or more; and 18 (3) must be enforced year-round. 19 (b-1) For the purposes of Subsection 20 (b)(1), 21 idling [Idling] is not necessary to power a heater air or conditioner if the vehicle is within two miles of a facility 22 offering external heating and air conditioning connections at a 23 time when those connections are available. 24

1 (c) No driver using the vehicle's sleeper berth may idle the 2 vehicle in a residential area as defined by Section 244.001, Local 3 Government Code, or in a school zone or within 1,000 feet of a 4 hospital or a public school during its hours of operation. An 5 offense under this subsection shall be punishable by a fine not to 6 exceed \$500.

[(d) This section expires September 1, 2009.]

8 SECTION 2. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality 9 shall adopt rules that comply with Section 382.0191, Health and 10 Safety Code, as amended by this Act, not later than January 1, 2010.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
