- 2 relating to requirements for attorneys in fact under Lloyd's plans.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 941.101(b), Insurance Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (b) Except as otherwise provided by this chapter, an
- 7 attorney in fact must:
- 8 (1) be a resident of this state; [and]
- 9 (2) maintain the attorney in fact's office in this
- 10 state; and
- 11 (3) be made a party to any suit brought to enforce the
- 12 obligations of the Lloyd's plan under a contract of insurance.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an insurance policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 15 renewed on or after January 1, 2010. A policy delivered, issued for
- 16 delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2010, is governed by the law
- 17 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 18 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
