5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 44.008, Education Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsection (d-2) to read as follows:
8	(d-2) If a school district has not filed a copy of the school
9	district's annual audit report in compliance with Subsection (d) by
10	the 180th day after the date specified by that subsection:
11	(1) the agency shall provide a written notification to
12	the district that specifies the date on which the audit report was
13	required by this section to be filed with the agency; and
14	(2) the district shall:
15	(A) if the district has an Internet website:
16	(i) post a statement on the website
17	informing interested persons that the district is more than six
18	months late in filing the district's audit report as required by
19	this section; and
20	(ii) maintain the statement described by
21	Subparagraph (i) on the website until the district files the
22	district's audit report in compliance with this section; and
23	(B) conduct a public meeting specifically for the

1	(i) publicizing, by reading into the record
2	of the meeting, the notification received by the district from the
3	agency under Subdivision (1); and
4	(ii) discussing the date on which the
5	district anticipates the audit report will be filed, as well as the
6	reasons for the district's failure to comply with the filing
7	requirement in a timely manner.
8	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
9	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
10	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
11	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

12 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
