- 6 effect on the date of the decedent's death, and the former law is
- 7 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 (b) Section 112.038, Property Code, as added by this Act,
- 9 and Section 111.0035(b), Property Code, as amended by this Act,
- 10 apply to a trust existing on or created on or after the effective
- 11 date of this Act.
- 12 (c) The intent of this Act is to clarify existing law.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
