## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the statute of limitations in a civil suit for sexual
- 3 assault.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 16.0045, Civil Practice
- 6 and Remedies Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 16.0045.  $\underline{10-YEAR}$  [FIVE-YEAR] LIMITATIONS PERIOD.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 16.0045(a), Civil Practice and Remedies
- 9 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) A person must bring suit for personal injury not later
- 11 than 10 [five] years after the day the cause of action accrues if
- 12 the injury arises as a result of conduct that violates:
- 13 (1) Section 22.011, Penal Code (sexual assault);
- 14 (2) Section 22.021, Penal Code (aggravated sexual
- 15 assault); or
- 16 (3) Section 21.02, Penal Code (continuous sexual abuse
- 17 of young child or children).
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 20 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- 21 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 22 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 23 that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
