A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

H.B. No. 1986

1 AN ACT

2 relating to protective orders against dating violence.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 71.0021(a), Family Code, is amended to

5 read as follows:

- 6 (a) "Dating violence" means an act by an individual that is
- 7 against another individual with whom that person has or has had a
- 8 dating relationship, or by an individual against another individual
- 9 who is in a dating relationship with a third individual with whom
- 10 the actor is or has been in a dating relationship or marriage, and
- 11 that is intended to result in physical harm, bodily injury,
- 12 assault, or sexual assault or that is a threat that reasonably
- 13 places the individual in fear of imminent physical harm, bodily
- 14 injury, assault, or sexual assault, but does not include defensive
- 15 measures to protect oneself.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 17 71.0021, Family Code, applies only to an application for a
- 18 protective order that is filed on or after the effective date of
- 19 this Act. An application for a protective order filed before the
- 20 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 21 date the application is filed, and the former law is continued in
- 22 effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
