A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the inclusion of a student representative on a

- 3 district-level planning and decision-making committee.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 11.251(b) and (e), Education Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The board shall adopt a policy to establish a district-
- 8 and campus-level planning and decision-making process that will
- 9 involve the professional staff of the district, parents, students,
- 10 and community members in establishing and reviewing the district's
- 11 and campuses' educational plans, goals, performance objectives,
- 12 and major classroom instructional programs. The board shall
- 13 establish a procedure under which meetings are held regularly by
- 14 district- and campus-level planning and decision-making committees
- 15 that include representative professional staff, parents of
- 16 students enrolled in the district, students, business
- 17 representatives, and community members. The committees shall
- 18 include a business representative without regard to whether the
- 19 representative resides in the district or whether the business the
- 20 person represents is located in the district. The board, or the
- 21 board's designee, shall periodically meet with the district-level
- 22 committee to review the district-level committee's deliberations.
- (e) The board shall adopt a procedure, consistent with
- 24 Section 21.407(a), for the professional staff in the district to

- 1 nominate and elect the professional staff representatives who shall
- 2 meet with the board or the board designee as required under this
- 3 section. At least two-thirds of the elected professional staff
- 4 representatives must be classroom teachers. The remaining staff
- 5 representatives shall include both campus- and district-level
- 6 professional staff members. Board policy must provide procedures
- 7 for:
- 8 (1) the selection of parents to the district-level and
- 9 campus-level committees; [and]
- 10 (2) the selection of community members and business
- 11 representatives to serve on the district-level committee in a
- 12 manner that provides for appropriate representation of the
- 13 community's diversity; and
- 14 (3) the selection of a student to the district-level
- 15 <u>committee</u>.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 17 school year.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
