- 1 by a governmental authority other than a branch of the federal
- 2 government, when being operated by or for the transportation of:
- 3 (1) the person who registered the vehicle under
- 4 Section 504.202(a) or Section 504.315(c), (d), (e), or (g); [or]
- 5 (2) a person described in Section 504.202(b) if the
- 6 vehicle is registered under that subsection; or
- 7 (3) the owner or operator of a vehicle displaying
- 8 <u>license plates described by Subsection (a)(2)</u>.
- 9 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 10 to the standing of a vehicle in a parking space or area designated
- 11 specifically for persons with physical disabilities on or after the
- 12 effective date of this Act. The standing of a vehicle in a parking
- 13 space or area designated specifically for persons with physical
- 14 disabilities before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 15 the law in effect on that date, and the former law is continued in
- 16 effect for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
