Sections 681.008(a) and (b), Transportation 5 Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 A vehicle may be parked for an unlimited period in a (a) 7 parking space or area that is designated specifically for persons with physical disabilities if [+ 8 9 [(1)] the vehicle: (1) is being operated by or for the transportation of: 10 11 (A) the person who registered the vehicle under 12 Section 504.202(a) [+] or 13 [(B)] a person described by Section 504.202(b) if 14 the vehicle is registered under that subsection; and 15 (B) displays [(2) there are displayed on the 16 vehicle] special license plates issued under Section 504.202; or (2) displays license plates issued by another state of 17 the United States that indicate on the face of the license plates 18 that the owner or operator of the vehicle is a disabled veteran of 19 20 the United States armed forces. 21 (b) A vehicle on which license plates described by Subsection (a)(2) or issued under Section 504.202 or Section 22 23 504.315(c), (d), (e), or (g) are displayed is exempt from the payment of a parking fee collected through a parking meter charged 24

1 by a governmental authority other than a branch of the federal 2 government, when being operated by or for the transportation of:

3 (1) the person who registered the vehicle under
4 Section 504.202(a) or Section 504.315(c), (d), (e), or (g); [or]

5 (2) a person described in Section 504.202(b) if the 6 vehicle is registered under that subsection; or

7 (3) the owner or operator of a vehicle displaying
8 license plates described by Subsection (a)(2).

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 9 10 to the standing of a vehicle in a parking space or area designated specifically for persons with physical disabilities on or after the 11 effective date of this Act. The standing of a vehicle in a parking 12 space or area designated specifically for persons with physical 13 disabilities before the effective date of this Act is governed by 14 15 the law in effect on that date, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 16
