Subchapter E, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is 4 5 amended by adding Section 1551.227 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 1551.227. STUDY OF AND COVERAGE FOR BARIATRIC SURGICAL PROCEDURES. (a) Not later than January 1 of each year, the board of 7 trustees shall annually study the issue of provision of bariatric 8 9 surgery coverage under a group health benefit plan offered under the group benefits program. The board shall determine the cost that 10 the state can be expected to incur and the benefits the state can be 11 expected to realize by providing coverage for bariatric surgical 12 procedures for state employees that is at least as extensive as the 13 benefit for bariatric surgery provided to Medicare beneficiaries 14 under the National Coverage Determinations Manual published by the 15 16 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services on February 15, 2006. (b) If the board of trustees determines that providing the 17 coverage described by Subsection (a) for the plan year following 18 the plan year in which the study is completed would be cost-neutral 19 or cost-positive to the state, the board shall provide the benefit 20 for the plan year following the plan year in which the study is 21 22 completed.
