| 4 | SECTION 1. Section 98.003, Health and Safety Code, as added |
| 5 | by Chapter 671 (H.B. 1373), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular |
| 6 | Session, 2007, is amended to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 98.003. DUTIES. The task force shall: |
| 8 | (1) develop a cost-effective plan for prevention, |
| 9 | early screening, diagnosis, and management of [to educate health |
| 10 | care professionals about the advantages and methods of early |
| 11 | screening, diagnosis, and treatment of] chronic kidney disease for |
| 12 | the state's population [and complications related to chronic kidney |
| 13 | disease based on the Kidney Disease Outcomes Quality Initiative |
| 14 | Clinical Practice Guidelines for Chronic Kidney Disease or other |
| 15 | medically recognized clinical practice guidelines]; and |
| 16 | (2) develop a plan for surveillance and data analysis |
| 17 | to assess the impact of [to educate health care professionals and |
| 18 | individuals with] chronic kidney disease [about the advantages of |
| 19 | end-stage renal disease modality education and early renal |
| 20 | replacement therapy, including in-center dialysis, home |
| 21 | hemodialysis, peritoneal dialysis as well as other access options, |
| 22 | and transplantation, before the onset of end-stage renal disease |
| 23 | when kidney function is declining; and |

- 4 by Chapter 671 (H.B. 1373), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular
- 5 Session, 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 98.006. REPORT. Not later than January 1, 2011
- 7 [2009], the task force shall submit its findings and
- 8 recommendations to:
- 9 (1) the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of
- 10 the house of representatives; and
- 11 (2) the presiding officers of the Senate Committee on
- 12 Health and Human Services and the Public Health Committee of the
- 13 house of representatives, or the appropriate committees of the 81st
- 14 Legislature.
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 98.009, Health and Safety Code, as added
- 16 by Chapter 671 (H.B. 1373), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular
- 17 Session, 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 98.009. EXPIRATION. The task force is abolished and
- 19 this chapter expires on September 1, 2011 [2009].
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect August 31, 2009.
