17	(B) contains at least one federal military base.
18	(f) The county assessor-collector of a county imposing a fee
19	under this section shall collect the additional fee for a vehicle
20	when other fees imposed under this chapter are collected. <u>If the</u>
21	county is included in a regional mobility authority, the [The]
22	county shall send the fee revenue to the regional mobility
23	authority [of the county] to fund long-term transportation projects
