1-13 (i) On request of <u>an honorably</u> [a] retired officer who holds a certificate of proficiency under this section, the head of the 1-14 [a] state or local law enforcement agency from which the officer retired shall [may] issue to the retired officer identification that indicates that the officer honorably retired from the 1**-**15 1**-**16 1-17 agency. An identification under this subsection must include a 1-18 photograph of the retired officer. 1-19

1-20 1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-23 1-24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
