- 2 relating to driver's licenses, commercial driver's licenses, and
- 3 personal identification certificates; providing a penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.001(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subdivision (7-a) to read as follows:
- 7 (7-a) "Resident" means a person who lives in this state
- 8 and has maintained residency in this state for a period of at least
- 9 60 days at the time of application for a driver's license or
- 10 personal identification certificate.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 521.029, Transportation Code, is amended
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 521.029. OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE BY NEW STATE
- 14 RESIDENTS. (a) A person who enters this state as a new resident
- 15 may operate a motor vehicle in this state for no more than 90 [30]
- 16 days after the date on which the person enters this state if the
- 17 person:
- 18 (1) is 16 years of age or older; and
- 19 (2) has in the person's possession a driver's license
- 20 issued to the person by the person's state or country of previous
- 21 residence.
- 22 (b) If a person subject to this section is prosecuted for
- 23 operating a motor vehicle without a driver's license, the
- 24 prosecution alleges that the person has resided in this state for

- 1 more than 90 [30] days, and the person claims to have been covered
- 2 by Subsection (a), the person must prove by the preponderance of the
- 3 evidence that the person has not resided in this state for more than
- 4 90 [30] days.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 521.054, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) A person commits an offense if, with intent to defraud
- 8 or harm another, the person fails or refuses to comply with
- 9 Subsection (b) or (c). An offense under this subsection is a Class
- 10 A misdemeanor.
- 11 SECTION 4. Section 521.101, Transportation Code, is amended
- 12 by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 13 (j) Except as provided by this section, each personal
- 14 identification certificate issued by the department:
- 15 <u>(1) must:</u>
- 16 (A) be in the same format;
- 17 (B) have the same appearance and orientation; and
- 18 (C) contain the same type of information; and
- 19 (2) may not include any information that this chapter
- 20 does not reference or require.
- 21 SECTION 5. Section 521.121, Transportation Code, is amended
- 22 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 23 <u>(c) Except as provided by this subchapter, each driver's</u>
- 24 license issued by the department:
- 25 (1) must:
- 26 (A) be in the same format;
- 27 (B) have the same appearance and orientation; and

- 1 (C) contain the same type of information; and
- 2 (2) may not include any information that this chapter
- 3 <u>does not reference or require.</u>
- 4 SECTION 6. Section 521.142, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 by amending Subsections (a) and (e) and adding Subsection (i) to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) An application for an original license must state the
- 8 applicant's full name and place and date of birth. This information
- 9 must be verified by presentation of proof of identity satisfactory
- 10 to the department. The department must accept [as satisfactory
- 11 proof of identity under this subsection] an offender identification
- 12 card or similar form of identification issued to an inmate by the
- 13 Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
- 14 (e) The application must include any other information the
- 15 department requires to determine the applicant's identity,
- 16 <u>residency</u>, competency, and eligibility.
- 17 (i) The department by rule may establish and implement a
- 18 process to verify that the applicant resides at the residence
- 19 address furnished by the applicant. The department may deny
- 20 issuance of a license to an applicant whose residence address
- 21 cannot be verified. This subsection does not apply to:
- 22 (1) a person described by Section 521.027; or
- 23 (2) a person who presents a certificate of
- 24 homelessness as approved by the federal government.
- 25 SECTION 7. Section 521.181, Transportation Code, is amended
- 26 to read as follows:
- Sec. 521.181. ISSUANCE OF DRIVER'S LICENSE. (a) On

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- 1 payment of the required fee, the department shall issue to each
- 2 qualifying applicant a driver's license of the class for which the
- 3 applicant has applied.
- 4 (b) The department may not deny the issuance of a driver's
- 5 license to an applicant who has otherwise established the
- 6 applicant's identity, residency, competency, and eligibility for
- 7 the driver's license in compliance with the express provisions of
- 8 this chapter.
- 9 <u>(c) The Public Safety Commission or the department may not</u>
- 10 adopt or enforce a rule that is inconsistent with this section.
- 11 SECTION 8. Section 522.021(c-1), Transportation Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (c-1) If the department requires proof of an applicant's
- 14 identity as part of an application under this section, the
- 15 department must accept [as satisfactory proof of identity] an
- 16 offender identification card or similar form of identification
- 17 issued to an inmate by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
- SECTION 9. Section 522.030, Transportation Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- Sec. 522.030. CONTENT OF LICENSE. (a) A commercial
- 21 driver's license must:
- 22 (1) be marked "Commercial Driver License" or "CDL";
- 23 (2) be, to the extent practicable, tamper-proof; and
- 24 (3) include:
- 25 (A) the name and mailing address of the person to
- 26 whom it is issued;
- 27 (B) the person's color photograph;

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1	(C) a physical description of the person,
2	including sex, height, and eye color;
3	(D) the person's date of birth;
4	(E) a number or identifier the department
5	considers appropriate;
6	(F) the person's signature;
7	(G) each class of commercial motor vehicle that
8	the person is authorized to drive, with any endorsements or
9	restrictions;
10	(H) the name of this state; and
11	(I) the dates between which the license is valid.
12	(b) Except as provided by this subchapter, each commercial
13	driver's license issued by the department:
14	<u>(1) must:</u>
15	(A) be in the same format;
16	(B) have the same appearance and orientation; and
17	(C) contain the same type of information; and
18	(2) may not include any information that this chapter
19	does not reference or require.
20	SECTION 10. The changes in law made by this Act apply only
21	to a driver's license, commercial driver's license, or personal
22	identification certificate issued on or after the effective date of
23	this Act. A driver's license, commercial driver's license, or
24	personal identification certificate issued before the effective

SECTION 11. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
