8	this section, "nursery" means a location required under Section
9	71.043 to be registered by a nursery owner.
10	(b) A nursery that maintains a permanent storefront for
11	purposes of selling or leasing, offering for sale or lease, or
12	otherwise distributing nursery products to the public shall:
13	(1) access the Internet website of the Parks and
14	Wildlife Department;
15	(2) print the sign required by Section 12.0105, Parks
16	and Wildlife Code, to be maintained on that website; and
17	(3) post the sign in a conspicuous location where it is
18	readily visible to customers.
19	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 12, Parks and Wildlife
20	Code, is amended by adding Section 12.0105 to read as follows:
21	Sec. 12.0105. INFORMATION ON NATIVE AND INVASIVE PLANT
22	SPECIES. (a) The department shall develop and maintain on the

2 (b) The department shall also maintain on the department's 3 Internet website a downloadable, printable sign that contains the 4 following wording in at least 14-point type:

DO YOU KNOW YOU HAVE MANY LANDSCAPING CHOICES?

6 <u>SOME PLANTS, ALTHOUGH LEGAL TO BUY AND SELL, MAY HAVE</u> 7 <u>NEGATIVE EFFECTS ON NATIVE WILDLIFE AND ECOSYSTEMS.</u> FOR MORE 8 <u>INFORMATION ABOUT PLANTS THAT ARE BENEFICIAL TO OUR TEXAS WILDLIFE</u> 9 <u>AND HABITAT AS WELL AS INVASIVE EXOTIC PLANTS, PLEASE VISIT THE</u> 10 <u>TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE AT (insert</u> 11 <u>appropriate Internet website address).</u>

12 SECTION 3. Not later than October 1, 2009, the Parks and 13 Wildlife Department shall post the sign required by Section 14 12.0105, Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by this Act, on the 15 department's Internet website.

16 SECTION 4. The department shall send a notice to each 17 nursery owner that, on September 1, 2009, holds one or more 18 registrations under Subchapter B, Chapter 71, Agriculture Code, 19 that informs the nursery owner of the requirements of Section 20 71.061, Agriculture Code, as added by this Act, and the requirement 21 that a nursery comply with that section not later than January 1, 22 2010.

23 SECTION 5. Section 71.061, Agriculture Code, as added by 24 this Act, applies only to a nursery beginning January 1, 2010.

25 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
