1-8 relating to the place for the convening of a county convention.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Section 174.062, Election Code, is amended by
1-11 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
1-12 follows:

1-13 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a [A] county
1-14 convention shall be held in a county if the county is not situated
1-15 in more than one state senatorial district.

1-16 (c) If the county executive committee for a political party
1-17 determines that no suitable location for the county convention is
1-18 available in the county, the county executive committee may apply
1-19 to the state executive committee of that political party to issue an
1-20 order permitting the county convention to be held at a location
1-21 outside the county. An order under this subsection must be entered
1-22 in the minutes of the state executive committee not later than the
1-23 30th day before the date the county convention is to be held.

1-24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
