## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the holidays for members of fire and police departments
3	in certain municipalities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 142.0013, Local Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
7	(d) A fire fighter or police officer is entitled to a paid
8	day off from working on September 11 of each year if:
9	(1) the fire fighter or police officer:
10	(A) agrees or is required to work on a holiday
11	during the same fiscal year and chooses to take that holiday on
12	September 11; or
13	(B) chooses to use a vacation day, a day in lieu
14	of a vacation day or holiday, or accumulated compensatory leave to

- 15 take a paid day off on September 11; and
- 16 (2) the fire fighter's or police officer's supervisor
- 17 does not require the fire fighter or police officer to work that day
- 18 to maintain minimum staffing necessary for public safety.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
