A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the designation of May 9 as Willie Velasquez Day.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 662.014 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 662.014. OPTIONAL HOLIDAY FOR WILLIE VELASQUEZ DAY.
- 7 (a) The 9th day of May shall be designated "Willie Velasquez Day"
- 8 in observance of the birthday of William "Willie" Cardenas
- 9 Velasquez.
- 10 (b) The administrative head of a state agency may allow an
- 11 employee of the agency to have a day off with pay on Willie
- 12 Velasquez Day in lieu of any other state holiday that occurs on a
- 13 weekday, other than a weekday on which an election is held
- 14 throughout the state, on which the state agency is required to be
- 15 open but on which the operations of the agency are required to be
- 16 maintained at only a minimum level.
- 17 (c) On Willie Velasquez Day, each state agency shall remain
- 18 open and conduct the operations of the agency at a minimum level.
- 19 (d) A holiday allowed under this section is in lieu of
- 20 another holiday prescribed by law. The total number of holidays in
- 21 a year to which an employee of a state agency is entitled is not
- 22 changed by this section.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
