## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the review of solid waste facility permits.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 361.0881 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 361.0881. PERMIT REVIEW. (a) Subject to Subsection
7	(b), the commission shall review a permit issued under this chapter
8	for a municipal solid waste facility if:
9	(1) the review is requested by:
10	(A) a state legislator representing the area in
11	which the facility is located or an area located one mile or less
12	<pre>from the facility; or</pre>
13	(B) a resolution of the commissioners court of
14	the county in which the facility is located or of a county with
15	territory located one mile or less from the facility; or
16	(2) the executive director finds that the permit
17	holder's compliance history for the preceding five years contains
18	violations that constitute a recurring pattern of conduct
19	demonstrating a consistent disregard for the regulatory process,
20	including the failure to make a timely and substantial attempt to
21	correct the violations.
22	(b) The commission is not required to conduct a review under
23	Subsection (a) more than once during a five-year period or within

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five years of the initial issuance of a permit.

1	(c) The commission by rule shall establish a review
2	procedure that includes:
3	(1) notice of the review and notice of the opportunity
4	<pre>for public comment:</pre>
5	(A) posted on the commission's Internet website;
6	and
7	(B) mailed to each person entitled to receive
8	notice of a permit application;
9	(2) a review of complaint records regarding the
10	facility received in the preceding five years to determine if there
11	is a pattern to the complaints, including a determination of:
12	(A) the number of complaints;
13	(B) the number of people lodging complaints; and
14	(C) the commission's evaluation of those
15	complaints;
16	(3) consultation with the commission enforcement
17	staff in the regional office responsible for overseeing the
18	<pre>facility;</pre>
19	(4) a review of all enforcement actions and notices of
20	violation by local and state agencies; and
21	(5) commission staff response to comments and a
22	commission decision regarding whether:
23	(A) the permit under review should be changed, as
24	required for permit applications and modifications; or
25	(B) the commission should take enforcement
26	action.
27	(d) This section does not apply to a permit:

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- 1 (1) for an industrial solid waste facility; or
- 2 (2) for a land application unit under Section 361.121.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 361.088(g), Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 repealed.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
