- 5 SECTION 1. Section 35.63, Business & Commerce Code, as
- 6 added by Chapter 307, Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular
- 7 Session, 2007, is amended by amending Subsection (f) and adding
- 8 Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 9 (f) The attorney general or appropriate prosecuting
- 10 attorney may:
- 11 (1) investigate an alleged violation of this section;
- 12 <u>and</u>
- 13 (2) sue to collect a civil penalty under this section.
- 14 (g) The attorney general or appropriate prosecuting
- 15 attorney may recover reasonable expenses, including court costs,
- 16 attorney's fees, investigative costs, witness fees, and deposition
- 17 expenses, incurred in recovering a civil penalty under this
- 18 <u>section.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 204.004, Business & Commerce Code, as
- 20 effective September 1, 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 204.004. <u>INVESTIGATIVE AND</u> ENFORCEMENT <u>AUTHORITY</u> [OF
- 22 CIVIL PENALTY]. (a) The attorney general or appropriate
- 23 prosecuting attorney may:
- 24 (1) investigate an alleged violation of this chapter;

- 2 (2) sue to collect a civil penalty under this chapter.

- 8 SECTION 3. (a) Section 1 of this Act takes effect only if
- 9 the Act of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, relating to
- 10 nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in existing codes does
- 11 not become law. If the Act of the 81st Legislature, Regular
- 12 Session, 2009, relating to nonsubstantive additions to and
- 13 corrections in existing codes becomes law, Section 1 of this Act has
- 14 no effect.
- 15 (b) Section 2 of this Act takes effect only if the Act of the
- 16 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, relating to
- 17 nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in existing codes
- 18 becomes law. If the Act of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session,
- 19 2009, relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in
- 20 existing codes does not become law, Section 2 of this Act has no
- 21 effect.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
